This study aims to describe the (1) anatomical and (2) physiological forms of violence contained in the novel "Laut Bercerita" by Leila S. Chudori. This study used descriptive qualitative method. Data sources are in the form of words and sentences that describe acts of violence in the novel "Laut Bercerita" written by Leila S. Chudori using reading, note-taking and documentation techniques.

The results of the analysis based on research on the novel "Laut Bercerita" written by Leila S. Chudori show that there are 44 data on acts of physical violence. It consists of 30 anatomical hardness data and 14 physiological hardness data. Anatomical acts of violence include repeated actions such as punches, kicks, shoves, punches, and slaps, accompanied by the use of additional objects or objects such as cigarettes, metal pipes, iron rulers, hangers, wire, shoes, ice blocks, and even red ants. On the other hand, acts of physiological violence involve tactics such as using black cloth to cover the eyes, using handcuffs and cables to tie the arms, and using detention or confinement measures in prison contexts. The organization involved in this action is known as the eagle troop.
