ABSTRACT

The Influence Of Emotional Maturity On Career Choices For Class XII Students At SMAS Plus Miftahul Ulum Tarate Sumenep. Aqidatul Mufidah

Keywords: Emotional maturity, career choices

This research was motivated by the background of low emotional maturity and career choices of students at SMAS Plus Miftahul Ulum Tarate Sumenep. This research aims to understand how emotional maturity influences decisions in choosing a career for class XII students at SMAS Plus Miftahul Ulum Tarate Sumenep. The approach applied in this research is quantitative with descriptive methods. The population studied consisted of 110 students, and the sample size was determined using the Slovin formula, resulting in 52 respondents. Sample selection was carried out using a random sampling technique through drawing lots. The instruments used were an emotional maturity scale and a career choice scale with a score range of 1 to 5. The validity test was carried out using total item correlation, while the reliability test used Cronbach's alpha. The results of the analysis show that the alpha value for the e<mark>motional</mark> maturity scale is 0.869 and for the career choice scale is 0.979. Hypothesis testing was carried out using simple linear regression analysis at a significance level of 5%. Based on data analysis, a significant value of 0.001 (p < 0.05) was obtained with a coefficient of determination (R Square) of 0.208. From this, it can be concluded that there is a significant influence between emotional maturity and career choice for class.
