The results of the research are that traditional leaders play the role of holders of hereditary local knowledge and wisdom, and become the main pillar in carrying out existing customs with the active involvement of traditional leaders in the Sapeken Islands. In the context of preserving the culture of the Bajo tribe, the role of traditional leaders is not only as an authoritative figure, but also as an agent of change who is able to adapt the tradition to remain relevant and sustainable in the midst of the dynamics of the times. The Tando traditional practices carried out by the Bajo tribe on Sapeken Island are as follows: *a. Panjajakan b. Mappetu Ada c. Maddupa d. Mappaisseng e. Mappaci*
