The results of the study conducted by the researcher show that the Social Service makes efforts to handle ODGJ from a social perspective only, and for medical treatment it is handed over to the Health Service, in this case the Social Service collaborates between agencies to provide appropriate treatment for people with mental disorders, for the obstacles felt by the Social Service, namely the lack of funds obtained by the Social Service in providing assistance to families of people with mental disorder
