This research aims to determine the implementation of the Sumenep district regent's regulation no. 14 of 2019 concerning the acceleration of stunting reduction in Sumenep district, especially East Banaresep village, Lenteng sub-district

The research method used in this research uses a qualitative research method with an empirical legal study type of research, data collection was carried out in primary and secondary ways through observation, interviews, documentation, observing directly in the field regarding the form of implementation of Sumenep Regency Regent Regulation no. 14 of 2019 concerning the acceleration of stunting prevention in Banaresep Timur village, Lenteng sub-district as well as collecting data through journals and theses that are relevant to this research. The theory in this research uses policy implementation theory which includes communication variables, resources, disposition, bureaucratic structure, the research object of this research, the Sumenep district government, the Sumenep district health service, village officials, village midwives, and the community.

The results of the research show that the implementation of Sumenep Regency Regent Regulation no. 14 of 2019 concerning the acceleration of stunting prevention in Banaresep Timur village, Lenteng sub-district has been implemented quite well, as well as working together through government elements from various sectors, especially in the Sumenep district health service which has made efforts to reduce the stunting rate in Sumenep district by involving all health centers throughout the district. Sumenep is also an effort to go directly to villages to look at the problem of stunting more comprehensively, because this problem of stunting cannot only be solved by the government alone but requires joint efforts to minimize the incidence of stunting in Sumenep district, such as starting from providing (PMT) controlling access to nutrition, implementing approach through family assistance, and controlling the extent of the development and reduction of stunting in Sumenep district by conducting an evaluation so that we can then measure and find a solution to the reduction in stunting rates in Sumenep district.
