

ABSTRACT

Fifth, provide additional activities (congregational noon prayers) which aim to instill a disciplined attitude within each student, and carry out evaluations. The influencing factor is the lack of awareness of students to implement a disciplinary attitude. This lack of awareness is due to a lack of attention from parents and family, which is a factor that influences the growth of discipline in students. Apart from that, the surrounding environment also greatly influences student behavior.
