

## **ABSTRAK**

### ***THE INFLUENCE OF SELF EFFICACY ON DECISION MAKING TO CONTINUE EDUCATION FOR CLASS XII STUDENT AT IPB HIGH SCHOOL***

*This research is based on the large number of student who do not continue their education for economic reasons, but researchers feel that economic problems are not the main factor because there are many factors that can influence student career decision making, including self efficacy. Therefore, this research aims to find education in class XII student at Pagerungan Besar Islamic High school. This type of research is quantitative with a correlational approach. The sample for this research consisted of 53 class XII student with a total sampling technique. Data collection in this research used a questionnaire instrument with a likert scale which had passed validity and reliability test with a total of 6 self efficacy items and 18 decision making items. The data analysis technique uses a simple linear regression analysis technique with the help of SPSS version for windows. Based on the results of the regression test, it shows that the correlation (R Square) is 0.401 with a significant value of  $p = 0.00$  ( $p < 0.05$ ), which means the level of correlation or relationship of self efficacy (X) to decision making (Y) of 40.1%. This shows that there is a positive relationship between self efficacy and decision making to continue education in class VII student at Pagerungan Besar Islamic High School.*
