The language register of the salt farming community is a variation of the language used by salt farmers in Pinggirpapas Village, Kalianget District, Sumenep Regency, which can only be understood by a few groups. So this research describes the language register of the salt farming community in Pinggirpapas Village, Kalianget District, Sumenep Regency, based on the stages of implementation, namely the presalt-making stage, the salt-making process stage, and the post-salt-making stage.

This research uses a qualitative descriptive approach to reveal and describe the data obtained. Data collection uses the skilled method with basic fishing techniques and the advanced techniques of capak semuka and capak tan semuka. This research uses the referential matching method in analyzing data because the determining tool for this research is the salt farming community, and determining element selection (*PUP*) is the technique.

The results of this research show that as many as 60 registers are used by the salt farming community in Pinggirpapas Village, Kalianget District, Sumenep Regency. The registers used in the pre-salt making stage are 21; in the process process, there are 28; and in the final stage, post-salt making, there are 11 registers.

The use of the language register of the salt farming community in this research was studied from a sociolinguistic perspective. The use of registers among salt farmers is used to show various processes in making salt.
