Abstract

This research aims to describe the polysemy of nouns and verbs in the Sumenep dialect of Madurese in Batang-Batang Daya Village, Batang-Batang District, Sumenep Regency. The research method used is a qualitative descriptive method. The data source comes from the stories of the people in Batang-Batang Daya Village. The method for providing data uses the listening method with skillful listening (SLC) techniques, recording techniques and note-taking techniques. The data analysis method uses the agih method with the help of the loss technique and the replacement technique. This research analysis is based on semantic studies. Data analysis begins by selecting the results of the data obtained according to the research objectives, then dividing the data obtained into two analysis groups of noun and verb categories, and analyzing polysemy based on the criteria for determining polysemy Palmer (in Pateda, 2016:221-222) Lyons (in Pateda, 2016: 219), and Chaer (2013: 103-104). And the source of polysemy is determined according to Djajasudarma (2016;67-69). The results of this research are the polysemy of nouns and verbs in the speech of the people in Batang-Batang Daya Village, Batang-Batang District, Sumenep Regency
