IMPLEMENTASI KEBIJAKAN PERLINDUNGAN SATWA ENDEMIK BURUNG KAKATUA JAMBUL KUNING DI PULAU MASAKAMBING KECAMATAN MASALEMBU KABUPATEN SUMENENP

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ABSTRACT

This study aims to evaluate the implementation of protection policies for the bird kakatua jambul kuning in the area, as well as to identify factors that influence the success of endemic animal protection.

In this research, descriptive qualitative methods were used. Data collection was carried out through interview, observation and documentation techniques. The data that has been collected is analyzed through several stages, namely data reduction, data presentation, and drawing conclusions. The object of this research is the implementation of policies related to endemic animals, especially the Kakatua Jambul Kuning Bird, on Masakambing Island.

The results of the research show that the conservation policy instruments for the protection of animal regulations are contained in Presidential Decree number 43 of 1978, law number 5 of 1990, government regulation number 7 of 1999, East Java Governor's decision 188/166/KPTS/013/2020 and Masakambing Village regulation number 1/perdes/435.424.103/2009, these regulations are regulations that sheltering the Kakatua Jambul Kuning bird. Implementation of the conservation of the endemic Kakatua Jambul Kuning bird on Masakambing Island within a bureaucratic structure often results in miscommunication between superiors and field workers, as well as coordination between office workers and guards in the field is hampered because the facilities and infrastructure are not met.
