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The requirement for students to be able to understand the lesson well is one of them, fluency in Indonesian that is good and right. Fluency in Indonesian can also help communicate with the surrounding environment. Of course, learning to communicate using good and correct Indonesian will further enhance students' insights on how to communicate using Indonesian that is good and right. The use of regional languages in this case is Madurese which often interferes with Indonesian language. This study aims to describe the existence of Madurese language interference with the Indonesian language in the discussion activities of class VIII students at Al-Bajigur Manding Sumenep Junior High School, and also to find out the Madurese language that is most often found in Madurese language interference with Indonesian. The second interference is the most common form of interference found.
