This study aims to describe the characteristics of imperative sentences in Madura in Talango Subdistrict, Sumenep Regency in the form of: structure and characteristics of sentences in Madura in Subdistricts of Sumenep Regency. This study uses a descriptive approach and qualitative research types to describe the findings obtained. The data in this study were obtained from the speech of the people of Sumenep City District as the main data while supporting data were obtained from the book Paramasastra madura, Malate Sato'or and Madurese short stories. The method used in this study is the listening method using tapping techniques.

The imperative sentences in Madura in Talango District, Sumenep Regency have imperfect sentence structures because most of the data that has been analyzed do not have the S element or are not subjected. The imperative sentences in Madura in Talango Subdistrict, Sumenep Regency consist of four types, namely the actual imperative sentences, invitations, invitations and prohibitions. Sentence imperative sentences and invitations are marked with the same word that is the word "mara, mayu / ayu" (let's, come on) in the level of the language "enjâ'-iyâ".
