This has an impact on the level of student interest in learning, especially in the subject of Physical Education, Sports Health).

The method used is descriptive quantitative method, the instrument in this study uses a questionnaire distributed online via google form with a sample of class X students at SMAN 1 Sumenep by using data collection techniques in the form of questionnaires. The sampling technique used is purposive sampling and the analysis technique used is to pour frequency into percentage form.

Interest from comparative studies on the general interest of students in attending education, sports and health at SMAN 1 Sumenep is moderate with the highest recurrence included in the moderate category, namely 227 students or 64.30%. The advantages of students in participating in real learning at SMAN 1 Sumenep are arranged as very high 8 students or 2.26%, high 32 students or 9.06%, moderate 227 students or 64.30%, low 75 students or 21.24%, very low 11 students or 3.11%.
