The results of the research on the dynamics of greeting between ethnic Madurese students at STKIP PGRI Sumenep are 1 Kangean student across dialects including Ako, Eson, keta, Engko' and some others, 2) Forms of greeting II for Kangean students across dialects including Kao, Kake, Peyang, Bè'nâ and others, 3) the form of kinship greetings including, Mang, Leng, Mbak, Kakak, 4) the form of greeting based on nicknames including Tiul, Luspi Uang, Mocay and some others, 5) other forms of greeting in Among them there are, Beb, Say, Bestie, Anjay and others. In addition to the forms in this research, there are also Fungi and Greeting Meanings.
