The purpose of this research is to find out the motives that drive underage marriages in the eastern village of jang-jang, Kangayan district, Sumenep district and to find out the extent of the role BP4 in carrying out its role to prevent underage marriages in the eastern village of Jang-Jang, Kangayan district, Sumenep district.

This type of research is descriptive qualitative research because it is considered capable of analyzing social reality in more detail. The results of this study are the first motives that encourage underage marriage in the east village of Jang-Jang.
