Educators (teachers) PJOK subjects are not in accordance with their competencies or majors, lack of discipline in teaching and learning activities, facilities and infrastructure to practice PJOK subjects inadequate and the application of curriculum that does not work properly. This condition is the cause of the low interest of students in attending PJOK subjects at Al-Bukhari Vocational School, District of Raas, Sumenep Regency. The purpose of this study is to find out how much students are interested in participating in PJOK subjects at Al-Bukhari Vocational School, District of Raas, Sumenep Regency.

This research belongs to the quantitative descriptive category. The population in this study were all students of Al-Bukhari Vocational School, District of Raas, with 94 students. The sampling technique is a saturated sample. The research instrument used guidelines for observation and questionnaires. Data collection techniques using observation and questionnaires. The data analysis technique uses descriptive statistics.

The results showed that the intrinsic factors of students' interest in taking PJOK lessons at Al-Bukhari Vocational School in Raas Subdistrict were as high as 32 students (34.04%). Extrinsic factors of students' interest in taking PJOK lessons at Al-Bukhari Vocational School in District of Raas are moderate, which is 36 students (38.30%). The interest of students in attending PJOK in Al-Bukhari Vocational School is high and low with 32 students (34.04%) respectively.
