

ABSTRACT

THE EFFECT OF CHARACTER EDUCATION TOWARDS CLASS V STUDENTS' RELIGIOUS BEHAVIOR THROUGH THE SCHOOL CULTURE AT SDIT AL-HIDAYAH SUMENEP. DELVI TRI RESKI NOVRIKADI

Keywords: Character Education, School Culture, Religious Behaviour.

This study aims to: (1) Know the state of the school culture at SDIT Al-Hidayah Sumenep, (2) Know the students' character of SDIT Al-Hidayah Sumenep, (3) Know the effect of character education towards religious behaviour of students' through the school culture at SDIT Al-Hidayah Sumenep.

This research was quantitative study with a survey approach. The population of this study was 450 students, while the sample consist of 76 students with an error rate of 5% was obtained through purposive sampling technique. Questionnaires with Likert scale, interviews and observations was used in this study as data collection technique. Normality tests and multiple linear regression test used as the test requirements analysis.

The results of this study indicate that: (1) There was a significant effect of character education towards religious behaviour, as evidenced by $t_{count} > t_{table}$ ($3.027 > 1.666$) and sig. t $0.03 < 0.05$, (2) There was a significant effect of the school culture towards religious behaviour, as evidenced by $t_{count} > t_{table}$ ($3.294 > 1.666$) and sig. t $0.02 < 0.05$, (3) There was a positive effect on character education and the school culture towards religious behaviour, as evidenced by $F_{count} > F_{table}$ ($14.283 > 3.12$) and the level of sig. F $0.00 < 0.05$. Calculation of the coefficient of determination (R^2) was able to explain 28.1%, for the remaining 71.9% was explained by other variables that not included in this study.
