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The family environment has an important role in children's education and its success so that parents as the responsibility for the family must really make the ladder a children's educational institution. The family factor is very important because it is the first environment, the primary environment. If the family environment experiences things that are not harmonious, for example the Broken Home caused by divorce and educational errors will affect the child which causes juvenile delinquency. However juvenile delinquency must be controlled because if it continues it will cause damage to their lives in the future. Apart from the family side, juvenile delinquency control must also be done from the adolescent's environment.

The purpose of this study was to determine the relationship between the implementation of the family environment and juvenile / student delinquency in MTs. Sunan Giri Lobuk Bluto This type of research is a correlative quantitative research. This research took place at MTs Sunan Giri Lobuk. The population in this study were all students of MTs Sunan Giri Lobuk, totaling 151. The sample used was 31 students with the technique used was proportional sampling. Data collection techniques allow objective data to be obtained. In this study, the data collection technique used a questionnaire technique.

Based on the results of data analysis, it is concluded that the family environment has a significant influence on juvenile delinquency at MTs Sunan Giri Lobuk Bluto. This can be seen from the calculated r value, which is 0.753, the greater the value of r table, namely 0.355 so that H_0 or the hypothesis that there is no influence of the family environment on juvenile delinquency at MTs Sunan Giri Lobuk Bluto is rejected and H_a or the hypothesis is that there is an influence of the family environment on
