ANALYSIS OF RELIGIOUS CULTURE IN STUDENT CHARACTER FORMING AT SDN KEPANJIN

Keywords: Religious Culture, Character Building

The purpose of this study is to find out how to shape the character of students through the school culture in Kepanjin State Elementary School. Based on these objectives, the researchers here will describe the formation of student character through the culture that exists in the school.

This research method uses a qualitative approach with the type of field research (field research). Data collection techniques used are interview, observation, and documentation techniques. The speakers in the interview were the principal, teachers for grades III, V and student representatives from the Kepanjin State Elementary School.

The results showed that: In shaping the character of students through the existing school culture including religious characters, with the form of habituation 1) praying and dhikr, 2) praying together 3) ablution and praying in congregation, 4) forming an honesty canteen in this habituation can raise the character of student discipline such as 1) praying on time, 2) coming to the Koran on time and honestly such as 1) paying for food in the canteen honestly, 2) telling the truth to others. As well as creating an attitude of obedience and understanding of religious teachings, living tolerant and harmonious with others. The formation of these characters is influenced by several supporting or inhibiting factors including: 1) personal students, 2) environment (friends), 3) parents, 4) rewards and punishment.
